Toolkit: Learning by Intercultural COOKING

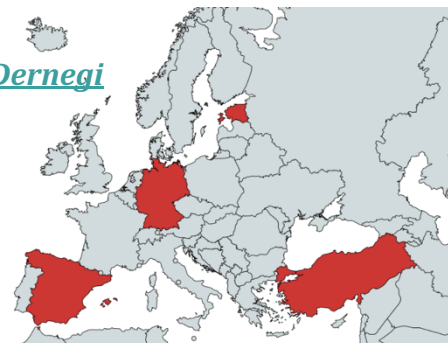
The main outcome of the project consist of an innovative educational material based on cooking recipes from all around the world in order to raise the motivation of the adult learners and to provide new tools for the educators.

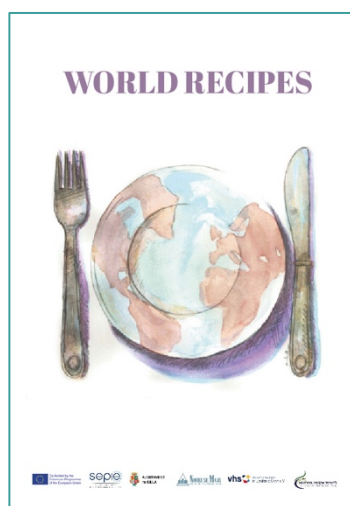


SWOT analyses and priorities
